The Water Conservation Advisory Council (council), created in 2007 by the 80th Texas Legislature, is composed of volunteers with expertise in water conservation representing twenty-three interest groups. Texas Water Code, Chapter 10, directs the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) to appoint members of the council.

To assist the TWDB in selecting the most appropriate individual for council membership, we respectfully request your consideration of nominating someone to represent **higher education** on the council with a term ending in August of 2021. Only one individual will be selected based on their commitment to and expertise in water conservation in addition to their affiliation with higher education in Texas.
