## Audits – Should I Ask For My Outside CPA's Most Recent Peer <u>Review</u>?

- Audits conducted under "Yellow Book" standards created by the Government Accountability Office require the independent outside CPA to obtain a peer review. The results of the peer review must be made available on request to the public (Para. 5.79, Government Auditing Standards, 2018 Revision).
- Requesting a copy of the CPA's peer review is optional, and at the discretion of the auditee.
