

Requirements in Senate Bill 181

Senate Bill 181 requires:

- calculating a water utility's total water use and use gpcd to represent that use
- calculating a water utility's water use by sectors: residential, commercial, institutional, industrial, and agricultural
- calculating a water utility's residential (single and multi family) and use gpcd to represent that use
- developing guidance for service population (permanent and temporary) used in gpcd calculations
- request for detailed information is directed at utilities with more than 3,300 connections with limitations on requiring new accounting systems

Deadlines:

- deadline of January 1, 2013 for TCEQ and TWDB in consultation with WCAC to develop the methodology, guidance and reporting program(s) required
- deadline of January 1, 2015 for TWDB to report: 1) the statewide water use by sectors of residential, industrial, agricultural, commercial, and institutional and 2) the data collection and reporting program for utilities with more than 3,300 connections
